

PARISH COUNCIL OF MINISTRIES MINUTES OF APRIL 17

On Tuesday, April 17, twenty one chairpersons of parish ministries and organization as well as interested parishioners attended the Parish Council of Ministries meeting at 6:30 PM. After an opening prayer of excerpts from Pope Francis' exhortation Rejoice and Be Glad, the council reviewed and accepted the minutes of the January 30 meeting. Father Clark gave an update of the fundraising progress for the church renovation. As of April 15, we have received pledges of \$282, 202.00. When we add the pledges to the money we already had in our Building Fund \$210,895.42, we have a total of \$493,497.42. Since September, 2017, \$172, 876.48 has already been paid on pledges. This means that we are able to enter into the next phase of our project which consists of securing a loan of \$500,000 from the Diocese, having the architect draw up actual plans, seeking the approval of the Diocesan Building and Liturgical Commissions, putting the project out to bids and choosing a contractor, and begin construction (possibly in the fall of 2018?). Since we anticipate a construction period of at least 8 months, all weddings, funerals and baptisms will take place in neighboring churches. We have received an invitation from Mr. Hall Davis to use the chapel at his funeral home on Scenic Highway for Sunday morning Masses. He is offering this service free of charge. The council unanimously supported this proposal. Father Clark will seek permission of the Diocese for this. The Vigil mass will most probably be held in the Activity Center. Father Clark asked the council for feedback about the design of the renovation. The council expressed approval and support of the design. We then had a discussion about preferences for benches: whether we should restore the existing benches or get new benches. The council expressed strong support for keeping the current benches and restoring and repairing them. We will explore the possibility of new kneelers and book holders.

Father Clark reported on planning that is taking place in the Jesuit Central Southern Province. Immaculate Conception is playing an important role in this process. He encouraged the chairs of parish planning committees (Building, Youth Faith Formation, and Adult Faith Formation) to keep moving forward in their efforts. He commended the Communication Committee for their work in keeping our website current and interesting. Father Clark expressed appreciation for the impact that the Lenten book, Rediscover Jesus, has had on the parish. Many people expressed how much they profited from the book. A copy of Pope Francis' exhortation Rejoice and Be Glad was distributed. We will discuss it at our next meeting in April.

Members shared the following news and announcements: Confirmation retreat at Angola was a positive and powerful experience for the candidates; KPC Conference in Baton Rouge this weekend (April 21-22). Reggie Berry is running for state office; Ron Q. Lewis met Bishop Carmen at nursing facility in New Orleans; he sends his regards to the parish; Confirmation will take place on May 3. Our 8 candidates will join St Francis and St. Paul's for a total of 23; MLK Study Night on Tuesday, April 24; KPC Jr. Knights will be having an initiation soon; Saint Vincent de Paul Conference is looking for volunteers. Volunteers are needed for weekends, too.

THANKS FOR KEEPING KFC LOT CLEAN




