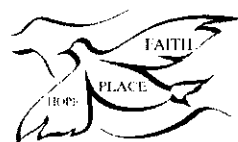


SPIRITUALITY OF SAINT IGNATIUS

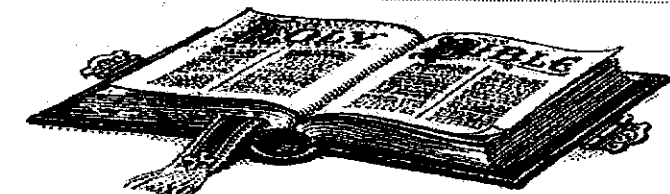
