**KNIGHTS AND LADIES LENTEN FISH DINNERS**

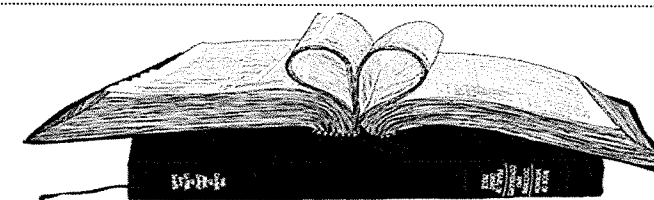
