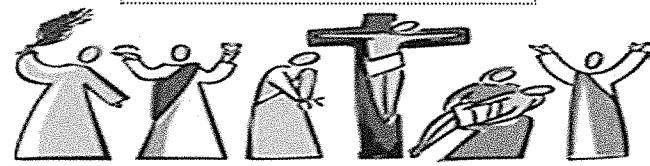

You can enter into the mystery of the dying and rising of the Lord by: taking part in the Palm Sunday walk from Scotlandville Plaza; participate in the foot washing on Holy Thursday; spend some time with Jesus in the adoration watch after Holy Thursday Mass; keep silence from 12 noon to 3:00 PM on Good Friday and come to church at 3:00 PM, the hour when Christ died; be there on Holy Saturday evening when three persons become members of our church; bring a small container to bring Easter water to bless your house; sing in the special Easter Sunday choir at 10:30 AM; be sure to welcome guests and new comers to church on Easter Sunday; spend 50 days after Easter rejoicing in the new life Christ has won for us!

ST. JOSEPH FEAST DAY CELEBRATION



The Traditional Choir will host the St. Joseph's Feast Day on Sunday, March 18, 2018 after the 10:30AM Mass. Historically, on the Saint Joseph's Day altar, people place flowers, limes, candles, wine, fruit, vegetables, fava beans, specially prepared cakes, bread, and cookies, and an Italian pastry called "zeppole". There is normally a three tiered altar, which represents the Holy Trinity, adorned with foods that are traditionally served containing bread crumbs to represent saw dust since Joseph was a carpenter.

The parish is invited to participate in the St. Joseph Feast Day celebration that will honor St. Joseph and St. Patrick. There will be hymns of praise and prayers for special intentions and vocations during this Lenten activity. We look forward to seeing you there.

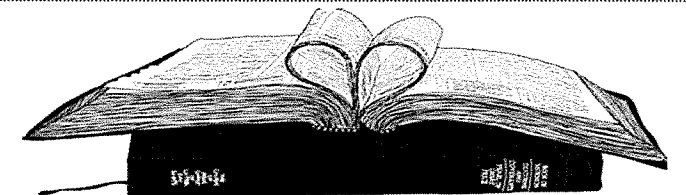
