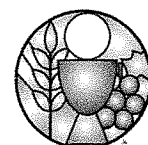
VISIT OF FATHER RON MERCIER, PROVINCIAL

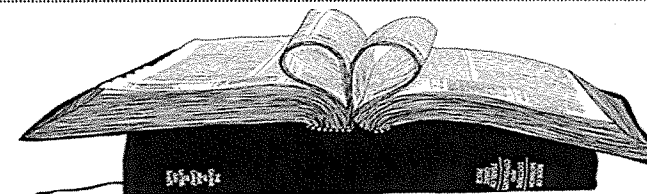
