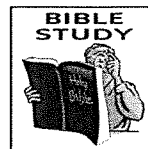

**RACIAL HARMONY COMMISSION:
LECTURE BY BISHOP EDWARD K. BRAXTON**



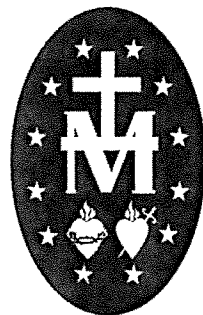
The Racial Harmony Commission of the Diocese of Baton Rouge will present a public lecture by the Most Reverend Edward K. Braxton, the Bishop of Belleville, Illinois on Thursday, September 27, 2018 at 7:00 PM at the Westerfield Center of the Catholic Life Center. The title of his talk will be: **LISTEN! LEARN! THINK! PRAY! ACT! The Catholic Church and the Racial Divide in the United States.** Everyone is welcome and admission is free. Bishop Braxton has written a pastoral letter on this topic as well as follow up lectures and articles. His lecture will include addressing the reasons why only a small number of African Americans are Catholic; the "All Lives Matter" vs. "Black Lives Matter" debate; the negative impact of the erroneous expressions "minorities" and "minority groups." He will also address the question of what the Catholic Church can do to help bridge the racial divide. This lecture is presented in collaboration with OLOL Franciscan University.

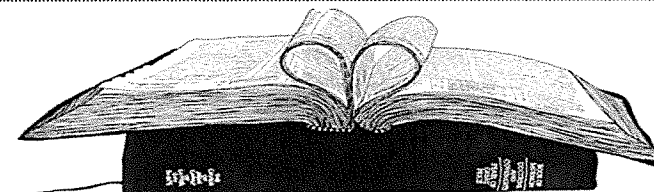
