
# **SOUTHERN UNIVESITY HOMECOMING 2018**

# RACIAL HARMONY COMMISSION: LECTURE BY BISHOP EDWART K. BRAXTON



The Racial Harmony Commission of the Diocese of Baton Rouge will present a public lecture by the Most Reverend Edward K. Braxton, the Bishop of Belleville, Illinois on Thursday, September 27, 2018 at 7:00 PM at the Westerfield Center of the Catholic Life Center. The title of his

talk will be: LISTEN! LEARN! THINK! PRAY! ACT! The Catholic Church and the Racial Divide in the United States. Everyone is welcome and admission is free. Bishop Braxton has written a pastoral letter on this topic as well as follow up lectures and articles. His lecture will include addressing the reasons why only a small number of African Americans are Catholic; the "All Lives Matter" vs. "Black Lives Matter" debate; the negative impact of the erroneous expressions "minorities" and "minority groups." He will also address the question of what the Catholic Church can do to help bridge the racial divide.
