Gospel Meditation

We can learn a great deal from Mister Rogers. Remember him? He was the gentle soul who found his way into living rooms worldwide starting as far back as 1968. Mister Rogers' Neighborhood was a beloved program that celebrated and exalted people, especially children. He taught us that we are neighbors and that everyone has a place. Everyone matters. He had a vision, born of his relationship with God that highlighted every human life's innocence, beauty, and uniqueness. To that end, he called us to be responsible for each other, saying nothing different than what Jesus said. Viewers quickly learned that life is not just about me.

"We live in a world in which we need to share responsibility. It's easy to say, 'It's not my child, not my com-

munity, not my world, not my problem.' Then there are acceptance. those who see the need and respond. I consider those people my heroes (Fred Rogers)." It is so easy to look was so popular. It the other way. After all, I'm not the one who needs to leave home out of fear and try to find somewhere safe. I am not the one who is hungry and without shelter or food. I am not the one who has a child being bullied or ridiculed because of the way they dress or act. I am not the one being threatened with violence or unable to find meaningful work. The distress and agony of our neighbors are our distress and agony. We cannot walk by it with an attitude of indifference, especially if we call ourselves believers. When we no longer care, we have suffocated our souls. This is a great sin.

God's law "is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out." We all have a need

for love and That's why Mister Rogers' television show spoke to something deeper, something sacred about humanity. God didn't give us his law in a book. He wrote it on our hearts. We know what we need to do. It's a matter of choice. Love is sacred. When we love another human being, especially without regard for ourselves, it is a holy moment. These moments are often missed due to our selfserving agendas and rules. **©LPi**

Next Steps

- Summer 2022: DMI results have been reviewed and considered among other information to draw conclusions about the current state of the parish and parish life.
- Fall 2022: Listening sessions at each parish to receive input and feedback on draft models.
- Winter 2022: Discernment and refinement of models.
- Pentecost 2023: Archbishop Rozanski announces the plan for the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Summer 2023: Pastors and parish leaders begin preparing for implementation.

What is the DMI?

This past Spring, parishioners here at St. Patrick and across the Archdiocese of St. Louis were invited to share their thoughts, reflect on their spiritual growth, as well as provide parish leadership with invaluable insight regarding their parish's strengths and opportunities through a survey, the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The DMI survey is designed to capture information regarding attitudes and beliefs, relationship and satisfaction, participation, and demographics using a quantitative tool that can be used for benchmarking and trending information.



Based on the average October Sunday Mass count from 2015-2021, about 60% of Mass-going Catholics participated in the DMI Survey. This is above the national average for other dioceses who have taken the DMI

Our Community

Last spring our parish had the opportunity to participate in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey. 868 adults in our parish - or about 45 percent of parishioners - took the time to give their feedback. The national participation average is between 7-10 percent, so this puts St. Patrick well above the national average.

The DMI survey contained 75-questions designed to provide an opportunity for parishioners to reflect on their individual spiritual growth and overall parish effectiveness.

Whether it is someone needing care, a wrong that must be rectified, an injustice that must be addressed, or someone in need of a helping hand, the lens through which we view life (and even the rules by which we live) can prevent us from stopping and acting. Whether it's an obsession with being on time, a compulsion to complete tasks according to a schedule, or a rigidity with not breaking a law or fear of taking a risk, we miss daily opportunities to show mercy. We often fail in our duty to be a good neighbor, especially when it involves brothers and sisters remote from us whom we have never met. The pain of the world is our pain. God's law of love, mercy, and compassion is not something remote. It's already within us and very near. All we have to do is open our eyes and carry it out. **©LPi**
