FAITH Alive in the Home in your Parish Serving Parents of Toddlers

FAITH is a peer-mentoring program that trains parishioners to provide in-home visits to parents of toddlers.

Modeled on Parents as Teachers, FAITH is also influenced by the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd philosophy and methods.

FAITH supports parents by assessing developmental stages of toddlers and modeling age-appropriate methods of forming the child's social, emotional and pre-school skills in the context of faith.

FAITH Alive in the Home PROGRAM:

- ❖ Is administered by the FAITH Director and regional Liaison
- ❖ Trains parishioners to be FAITH Facilitators, to visit 1 3 families 8 10 times a year
- Supervises Facilitators and collaborates with a Facilitator-Coordinator in your parish
- Offers parent sessions and Cross-generation family gatherings, and provides child-friendly faith materials
- Fosters adult faith-formation through personal relationships that bond young parents to the church community

Mission	Our mission is to support parents as First Teachers of the Faith by fostering their faith growth, and modeling ways to integrate faith in their toddler's formation and all areas of family life.
Model	 Home visits providing researched methods of building faith in the family Individualized goal-setting for family faith development Shared monitoring of child's developmental milestones that include faith Scripture-based curriculum influenced by Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Family engagement in parish liturgical, social and service opportunities Referral to professional services as needed to meet child/family needs
Goals	 Emphasize the holiness of a parent's vocation Foster parenting competence and personal faith Assist parents in creating family faith-based rituals Strengthen family relationships within a parish community Support parents in consciously nurturing their child's relationship with Jesus Engage child in developmentally appropriate activities focused on faith Encourage child's continued formation in Catholic schools or PSR
Methods	 Affirming parental strengths while offering opportunities for personal growth Building relationships with families through monthly home visits Assisting parents in meeting their family faith goals Imbedding faith in childhood exploration, play and family home environment Providing resources for engaging children with faith-based activities
Distinctive Features	 Supports families from child's birth through pre-school Allows each family to evaluate their faith practices and set personal goals Offers parent faith sharing circles and liturgically themed family interactive gatherings Incorporates Virtue-based Discipline and Restorative Practices in the home Helps form relationships among young Catholic Families in a parish
FAITH Results	In initial implementation with FAITH families: 100% experienced an increase in personal and family prayer 80% reported greater comfort with discipline using virtue-based methods 65% cited increased Mass attendance 100% found family faith gatherings enriching Results apply to families of diverse ethnicity, race, economic level and parish locations.
