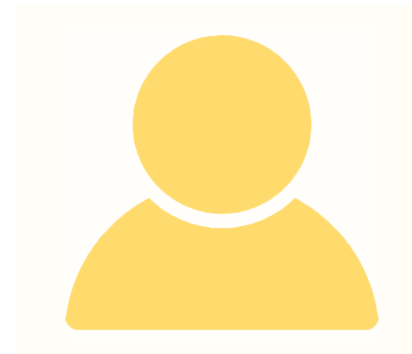

Paschal Candle

*The Easter candle is a sign to us for Christ's undying presence, of his victory over sin and death and our sharing in that victory by virtue of our Baptism.*
