(1792-1879, France)


Feast: August 30 St. Jeanne Jugan lived in France during the French Revolution which terrorized Christians. Despite this, her mother brought her up to love God. One day, she met a poor, sick and lonely old woman and decided to bring

her home. Soon she started taking care of more elderly persons with friends' help. She eventually founded the Little Sisters of the Poor, a

religious order that looks after the elderly poor. St. Jeanne is also known as Sister Mary of the Cross and she is the patron saint of the destitute elderly.

Dear Lord Jesus, give me the grace to love, respect and care for the elderly. Amen.

Dear Saint Jeanne Jugan, help us to see all people as children of God. Help us always to respect each person's dignity. Help us to show special respect to the elderly, and to care for them as you did. Amen. Saint Jeanne Jugan, pray for us

#### **Holy Week Event: April 8**

# Protecting God's Children - MUST READ!

If you have ever taken at Protecting God's Children Workshop at any time or anywhere, you must RE-REGISTER before December 31, 2020.

Otherwise, if you minister to children or vulnerable adults, you will not be able to work or volunteer at St. Patrick Church, School, SVDP, CYC Sports, Meals on Wheels, etc.

Prevent and Protect - This link will take to you the Prevent and Protect STL website where you can:

- Sign In to Your Account (after you sign in you can re-register with Prevent and Protect STL)
- Register for a New Account
- View & Register for Upcoming Workshops (yellow box)
- Find Information about Preventing and Reporting Abuse (blue & red boxes)
- Find Codes of Conduct and Policies (gray boxes)
- Find Outreach and Support (green box)

St. Patrick Catholic Church and School follow the Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program, now referred to as the Prevent and Protect STL program that offers the Protecting God's Children Workshop. The program is designed to help protect the youth, elderly, and vulnerable adults of our parish as they participate in activities within our community.

Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. **This includes EVERYONE - those new to service and those who are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a live Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system.

In addition to attending a previous Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will:

- Register for an updated background screening
- View two new online training modules on Abuse Reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct
- Agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct
