

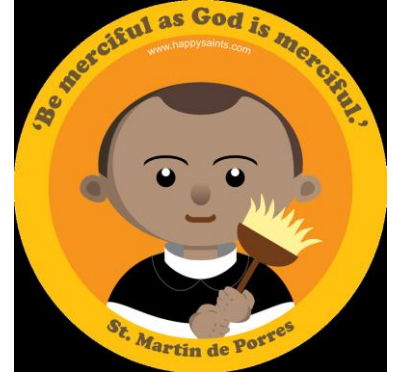

Saint of the Week: **Saint Marin De Porres**

Patron Saint of the Week: Saint Marin De Porres, Class1C

St. Martin de Porres (1579 - 1639) was born in Lima, Peru, to a Spanish father and a freed slave mother from Panama. When he was 15, he became a servant in the Dominican Friary, doing many chores including being a barber and a farmer! He was very kind and compassionate to the poor and the sick. He also loved animals! Later he became a Lay Dominican Brother. He lived an austere life helping people of all races in Lima. Sometimes he brought poor sick people home and put them to sleep in his own bed. He is the patron saint of mixed race people and barbers. His feast day is on 3 November.



Dear Lord Jesus, St. Martin de Porres glorified You even as he swept floors and did other mundane chores. I will also praise You in the small things I do.

Saint Martin de Porres, help us to treat all people with thoughtfulness. Help us to listen to others, take turns, and share. Amen.

We have been asked by the Sts. Joachim and Ann Care Service to help in supplying items for the Needy families of the area. I think these are projects that all classes can share in participating as a PSR Service Project this year. We would not be adopting a specific family but bringing items that will be distributed among the families. Attached are some of the items suggested. *You can send the list home to parents or decide you would like for your class to do a particular item.* This will have to be done soon because the items have to be delivered to the care Center by December 12th.

- First Grade: Puzzles, tea sets, stuffed toys, Barbie dolls, Barbie doll accessories, t-shirts, hats, gloves, little cars, trucks, action figures, books, socks, underwear, pajamas and educational toys.
- Second Grade: Puzzles, play dough, hair accessories, t-shirts, small cars, trucks, planes, educational toys, jewelry, games and Legos
- Third Grade: Games, books, Legos, t-shirts, caps, hats, gloves, trucks, planes, dolls and accessories, hair accessories, purses, video games, educational toys
