St. Patrick Altar Server

Becoming an altar server means you are serving God and His people at Mass. What you do while you are serving and how you do it helps other people focus on the Mass and express their love for God. As an altar server, you must actively participate in Mass so that other people will do so as well.

Altar server expectations:

- Arrive at Mass at least 10 minutes early.
- Fulfill your obligation to serve at your assigned times.
- Find a replacement if you are unable to serve at your assigned time.
- Wear appropriate clothing to weekend Masses.
- Pay attention to the priest at all times. He may require your assistance at any time throughout the Mass.
- Participate in the Mass, including singing and responses.

By signing below, you are stating that you are interested in becoming an altar server and you agree to the above expectations. Servers who do not abide by these expectations may be removed from the server schedule.
