- Read the **PARENTAL WITNESS STATEMENT CAREFULLY**, sign and return with the registration forms. Please be aware of the promises you are making in the last paragraph. Also, sign the publication release at bottom of page. When registering your child, you acknowledge that you will show an ongoing interest in their religious training by regularly attending Sunday Mass and PSR classes. Parents of children in Sacramental classes will have mandatory parent sessions to attend.
- A **\$40 non-refundable registration fee per** will guarantee your preference of session. Without this fee, no class time will be assigned and you will not be officially registered until the fee is paid.

Witness Statement For Those Whose Children Attend Religious Education:

One of the supreme gifts of marriage is bringing forth new life. God entrusts children to parents who have a primary right and duty to educate their children in the practice of their faith. Parents carry out this responsibility by creating a home full of love forgiveness, respect and fidelity. The family is the community in which, from childhood, one honors God and learns moral values.

In the rite of the sacrament of Baptism, parents receive the call from God to evangelize their children, as here summarized:

You have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him (her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him (her) up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving Dad and our neighbor... You will be the first teachers of your child in the ways of the faith. May you be also the best of teachers, bearing witness to the faith by what you say and do, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

No wonder then, that the church understand the home to be the domestic church. It is in the intimate environment of the family that parents are, by word and example, the first heralds of the faith with respect to their children. This environment is enhanced and deepened through the parish Eucharistic Community that is the heart of the spiritual life for Christian families.

Catholic Schools and parish religious education programs are in partnership with the family in proclaiming and witnessing to the person and life of Jesus Christ. They assist parents in fulfilling their responsibility as the primary religious educators of their children. This partnership works best when parents respect the beliefs of the Church and live lives in a manner that reflect these beliefs. If parents reject the beliefs of the Church or live lives in conflict with these teachings, catechizing young people becomes very difficult.

Aware then of the dignity of this holy parental call, and with a reverent awe for that responsibility which is mine, I commit myself to be, in word and deed, the first and best teacher of my children in the faith. Practically, this means I will:

- Understand that the authentic teachings of Jesus as taught by the Catholic Church will be part of my child's education and formation;
- To the best of my ability respect the teachings of the Church and help my children respect the Church and its teachings;
- Regularly participate in the Sunday Eucharist with my family (if not Catholic, support my children's participation in the Church of Baptism), include prayer in my daily life and form my children in the faith.
- Commit to speak frequently with my children about God and to include prayer in our daily home life;
- Participate in and cooperate with the School or Parish School of Religion in programs that enable me as a parent to take an active role in the religious education of my children, including sacramental preparation for Catholic children;
- Support the moral and social doctrine of the Catholic Church to ensure consistency between home and school;
- Teach my children by word and example to have a love and concern for the needs of others;
- Meet my financial responsibilities in supporting the Catholic school or the Parish School of Religion.
- Practice stewardship in support of the school and parish.

Safe Touch Curriculum: As a caring Catholic Community, and as part of our ongoing commitment to provide a safe and healthy environment for our children, the Archdiocese Child and Safety Committee has developed a school based curriculum for grades K-8 that contains practical and helpful information to help children protect themselves from the dangers that exist today. The objective of the curriculum, entitled Safe Touch, is to teach children self protection skills. Children learn body safety rules in an age appropriate and non-threatening manner. This curriculum will be presented by a trained leader in our parish. It will take ½ of the class period. The Safe Touch curriculum approaches safety issues in a respectful manner, connecting our Catholic Values with information to keep our children safe. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or concerns regarding this important piece of your child's education. You may come into the school office during PSR class time any time before the dates we present to preview the material. If for whatever reason you prefer your child not hear the presentation, you have the option of opting out from the program. Please come to the office and get a form to sign for opting out. We can provide you with the materials to discuss with your child at home.

 - Dine & Save card & the Imo's BOGO Card.

How does SCRIP work?

- *One simple example: SCRIP pays \$95 for a \$100 Dierberg's card. You purchase this card for \$100, you get a card worth \$100 and SCRIP earns \$5 in profit.

Where and when do you buy SCRIP?

- *Before & after weekend masses
- *Through PSR via your child—Sunday 5pm Mass is the weekly deadline to ensure your on hand order or preorder comes home on Wednesday.

SCRIP PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

St. Patrick Parish sponsors a Scrip program. The Scrip you purchase through our program generates cash rebates from the participating retailers. These rebates, after the deduction of an administration fee, can be applied to your PSR tuition for the following school year. In consideration of your participation in the scrip program, we agree as follows:

1. The parish will operate this SCRIP program on behalf of parishioners from such retailers and in such quantities as the parishioners designate from time to time, subject to the approval of the parish.
2. The parish may purchase SCRIP in advance of your order to be held as inventory for the SCRIP program. The parish will only make advance purchases in such quantities and types as are consistent with your and other participants' purchase history and anticipated purchases.
3. For PSR, High School and Pre-School tuition, the 50% rebate will be applied AFTER the first \$100 in SCRIP profits is reached. You must be registered for the following school year at St. Patrick or a Catholic high school.
4. The balance (after administration fees) of your rebates will be credited to tuition and allocated to the following students (please insert names of students as applicable):
