Patron Saint of the Week: St. Catherine of Siena, Class 7B

St. Catherine of Siena (1347 - 1380) was an Italian mystic, or a person who experienced God supernaturally. When she was six, she saw guardian angels! She became a Dominican Tertiary, meaning she was not a nun but still a Dominican. At that time, the Pope had moved to France because of troubles in Rome. St. Catherine successfully persuaded him to return to Rome and helped restore order there. Later she received the Stigmata (the Wounds of Christ). She is the patron saint of Italy. Her feast day is on 29 April.



Dear Lord Jesus, it is wonderful to receive visions of You, Mother Mary and the Saints as St. Catherine did. Whether I receive them or not, let me be thankful for everything You have done for me. Amen.
