The ashes we receive on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday are an annual reminder of the passage of time and our constant need of repentance. The ashes are made from burning the palms which were blessed on the previous Palm Sunday. We waved palms in praise of Christ at the beginning of Holy Week, and now we must call to mind humbly that we have failed him many times since then. Even in their origin, therefore, palms show the passing of this world and all created things.

Centuries ago it was the custom at the beginning of Lent to sprinkle ashes on public sinners as they came to the church in repentance.

Now we acknowledge publicly that we are all sinners and in need of transformation. Marking a person's forehead is an ancient symbol of ownership. Receiving the ashes in the shape of a cross identifies us as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Carrying the ashes on our foreheads indicates our willingness to do penance for our sins. Lent gives us the spiritual opportunity to change: ashes remind us of this. The traditional words used as the ashes are placed provide a timely reflection: "Remember that you are dust and to dust you will return."

## Protecting God's Children — MUST READ!

If you have ever taken at Protecting God's Children Workshop at any time or anywhere, you must RE-REGISTER before December 31, 2020.

Otherwise, if you minister to children or vulnerable adults, you will not be able to work or volunteer at St. Patrick Church, School, SVDP, CYC Sports, Meals on Wheels, etc.

St. Patrick Catholic Church and School follow the Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program, now referred to as the Prevent and Protect STL program that offers the Protecting God's Children Workshop. The program is designed to help protect the youth, elderly, and vulnerable adults of our parish as they participate in activities within our community.

Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. **This includes EVERYONE - those new to service and those who are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a live Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a previous Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will:

- Register for an updated background screening
- View two new online training modules on Abuse Reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct
- Agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct
