




Logging In



The first page you will see is the Returning Family Home Page. This page will have important reminders about your child's scholarship.






Step Three: Family Financials


Step Four: Verification

Due to high volume, we cannot accept mailed, emailed, or faxed responses. You will be able to access this page to submit or edit responses until February 28th, 2020. Students currently receiving a Beyond Sunday Fellows scholarship are not required to submit responses or references for requalification.**</u>
