Information regarding how to apply was included with the tuition information. **YOU MUST RE-APPLY every year. The deadline is February 28, 2020. ALL ST. PATRICK FAMILIES ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY!**

## **Alive in Christ Scholarship - New & Re-Qualifying Families**

Provides financial assistance to families (both Catholic and Non-Catholic). Awards are based upon the financial need of the applicant and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Students who are new to the school will be considered in grades K-4 and students already attending St. Patrick will be accepted at any grade. For more information visit:

## **Beyond Sunday Elementary & Fellows Scholarship - New & Re-Qualifying Families**

Open to students of all faiths, with preference given to Catholic students whose families are Catholic and registered in a parish in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Elementary school awards renew through the 8th grade, and high school awards renew through the 12th grade. Annual income requalification is required for all awards. For the 2020-21 school year, new Beyond

Sunday Elementary Scholarships will be tiered based on family income, with a maximum award amount of \$1,750. About 155 new awards are available. A minimum annual tuition payment of \$500 per student is required. Open to both new and existing students, limited to one per family per school, though families may be eligible for additional tuition assistance through other programs. ### **Catholic Families Tuition Assistance – Catholic Families Only**

Grants are on the basis of financial need as determined by the application process. Annual income guidelines are not published because both income/annual expenses are considered in award process. The 2020-21 application deadline is February 28th, 2020. Students who are new to the school and those who already attend will be considered. 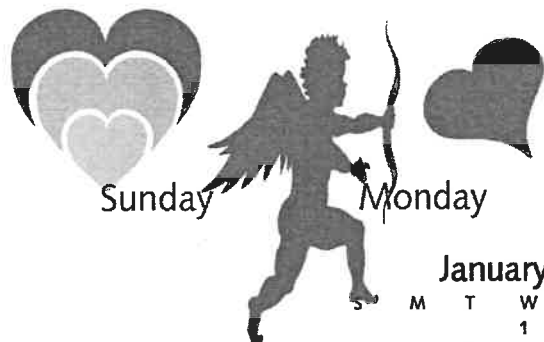

### **ALL ST. PATRICK FAMILIES MUST REGISTER THROUGH FACTS FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR**

- Annual (2% discount) – May be paid by check made payable to St. Patrick Parish, cash or through FACTS. Due by 4:00pm on Friday, July 24, 2020 in the parish office.
- 10-month payment plan, (August through May) – Payments will be made through FACTS.
  - FACTS is a tuition payment and processing system. FACTS accepts payments ACH through checking or saving accounts or credit card. Once registered with St. Patrick School, you will receive further directions via email.
    - NOTE: There is a set-up fee of \$50.00 for FACTS.

### **NOTE:**

- ♣ **10% Discount** in tuition for children in Early Childhood Program if families have multiple children in Preschool /Pre-Kindergarten and/or Kindergarten - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade.
- ♣ **EARLY CHILDHOOD \$250 REBATE PER YEAR** – Parents whose children attend our early childhood program and continue on in Kindergarten at St. Patrick School will receive \$250 toward their kindergarten tuition. For example, if your child attends preschool and pre-kindergarten at St. Patrick School and continues on in kindergarten, you will get \$500 off your kindergarten tuition at St. Patrick School.
- ♣ **NEW FAMILY REFERRAL \$250** – Refer a family to St. Patrick School and receive \$250 off your tuition. The new family must register and attend the 20-21 school year.

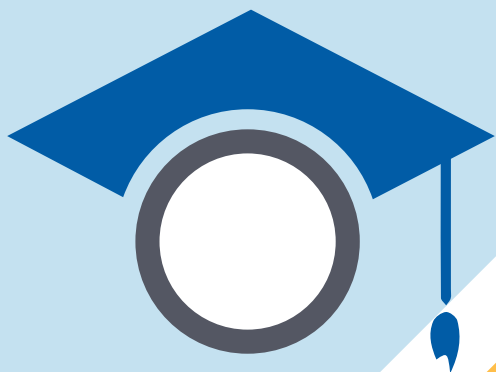




