The Today and Tomorrow Foundation is offering tuition assistance/scholarships again this year. Some of these scholarships are on a first come, first serve basis, so do not delay applying! Information regarding how to apply was included with the tuition information. YOU MUST RE-APPLY every year. The deadline is February 28, 2020. ALL ST. PATRICK FAMILIES ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY!

Alive in Christ Scholarship - New & Re-Qualifying Families

Provides financial assistance to families (both Catholic and Non-Catholic). Awards are based upon the financial need of the applicant and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Students who are new to the school will be considered in grades K-4 and students already attending St. Patrick will be accepted at any grade. <u>Beyond Sunday Elementary & Fellows Scholarship - New & Re-Qualifying Families</u>

Open to students of all faiths, with preference given to Catholic students whose families are Catholic and registered in a parish in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Elementary school awards renew through the 8th grade, and high school awards renew through the 12th grade. Annual income requalification is required for all awards. For the 2020-21 school year, new Beyond Sunday Elementary Scholarships will be tiered based on family income, with a maximum award amount of \$1,750. About 155 new awards are available. A minimum annual tuition payment of \$500 per student is required. Open to both new and existing students, limited to one per family per school, though families may be eligible for additional tuition assistance through other programs. The 2020-21 application deadline is February 28th, 2020. For more information visit: http://ttef-stl.org/beyond-sunday/

Catholic Families Tuition Assistance – Catholic Families Only

Grants are on the basis of financial need as determined by the application process. Annual income guidelines are not published because both income/annual expenses are considered in award process.  - View two new online training modules on Abuse Reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct
 - Agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct




Logging In


Step Three: Family Financials


Step Four: Verification

If you were not able to upload all required financial/residency documentation, please click **Print Form** in Step Five and follow instructions on the form to submit any documents listed that still need to be submitted. Please do not send duplicate copies of documents already submitted. **PLEASE REMEMBER that the short answer responses and reference contact information <u>must be submitted through the online application system by the deadline of February 28th, 2020 if applicable. Due to high volume, we cannot accept mailed, emailed, or faxed responses. You will be able to access this page to submit or edit responses until February 28th, 2020. Students currently receiving a Beyond Sunday Fellows scholarship are not required to submit responses or references for requalification.**</u>



Application Confirmation & Review

All new and re-applying families who successfully submit an online application will receive an automatic email response from our website. This should appear in your email from ttef@archstl.org. If you are missing any documentation, this does not mean your application is complete, only that the online form was submitted for Steps 1-4. Applications are reviewed in the order received by the TTEF Scholarship Office.
