# Technology News

## **GoGuardian:**

For the 2019-2020 school year will be using GoGuardian to monitor students work activities on their Chromebook and windows devices. GoGuardian monitors all websites and internet activity and reports to teachers and admins about inappropriate web surfing.. This year grades 5-8th are been monitored. In addition, we are using other methods to keep them on the right track when using internet resources. If your child uses their St. Patrick Google account at home, GoGuardian will automatically protect them at no cost to parents. We introduced GoGuardian in the 2017-2018 School Year.

## **BARK!:**

For the 2019-2020 school year we will also be using the FREE service called Bark for all grade levels. BARK is our anti-bullying protection plan that seeks out keywords in documents and much more alerting us to any potential cyber-bullying, drug/alcohol, violence, depression or self-harm issues. BARK has a free Parent app that monitors these issues after school hours (3pm-8am), holiday breaks and over the Summer. Please send Mr.Kalist an email if you would like a Free BARK account that includes monitoring from your smartphone (iPhone/Android). BARK also offers a 20% discount on their paid App that monitors your entire family and over 35 social media apps. We introduced BARK in the 2018-2019 School Year.
