


GRANDPARENTS' DAY!

Instructions for our Grandparents

1. Please arrive between 8:45am & 9:00am and enter the school building through the GYM doors. There is a ramp for anyone needing assistance.
Note: Grandparents of pre-kindergarten children have different instructions for Mass. Please see the note from your teacher.
2. Please be seated in the folding chairs in the middle of the gym. Your grandchildren will be seated in the bleachers for Mass.
3. Following Mass, the students will be dismissed to their classrooms first. You will then be asked to pick up your grandchild(ren) from the classroom(s). Students will be standing by to assist you.
4. The youngest child of each family will be given a card with different stations to visit. We ask that you please follow the order on the card so that we can manage the flow of people.
5. At approximately 11:15am, we will ask that grandparents take their grandchild(ren) back to the classrooms and begin to exit the building. If you are taking your grandchildren with you, PLEASE be sure to return to the classroom to sign the students out with the teacher.
6. Grandparents should enter their vehicles and wait for a faculty and/or staff member to dismiss them at 11:30am.
7. **THERE SHOULD BE NO MOVEMENT OF ANY VEHICLES BETWEEN 11:20AM AND 11:30AM UNLESS GIVEN THE SIGNAL. PLEASE ASK THE GRANDPARENTS TO ABIDE BY THIS GUIDELINE FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CHILDREN.**
8. Following the dismissal of the grandparents, the parking lot will reopen for our noon dismissal parents picking up students.
9. Head to  for our SPIRIT DAY fundraiser!




