The basis for starting this devotion is first, to introduce the Flame of Love to St. Patrick Parish. Second, it is to provide an opportunity for moms (dads, grandparents) to participate in this rosary prayer with children. All are welcome and we invite kids of all ages to lead the rosary, giving the young children of our parish a unique opportunity to come together and pray. Families may stay the whole time or just for one decade. This is more about promoting the Rosary to youth and praying and less about teaching. If your kids just are not “there yet” in praying the rosary, just pray it anyway in their presence and enjoy the joyful noises they are making to the Lord.
