2021-2022 School Uniform Information!

Sportsprint will be the new source for St. Patrick uniform shirts, pullovers, PE uniforms, and our preschool/pre-kindergarten children's shirts and bags. Fischer's will continue to be the source for our St. Patrick plaid jumper and skirt for the girls.

<u>Uniform orders must be placed ONLINE</u>. When you go to the online store from <u>www.stpatrickwentzville.org</u> you will see "Uniform Apparel". These items are acceptable for the school uniform. Anything below "New Items" are NOT included in the school uniform; however, may be worn on "Spirit Days".

IMPORTANT INFORMATION WHEN ORDERING: Please plan ahead when ordering! The Sportsprint store is open on a month by month basis, then closed for production and shipping. If an order is placed at any time between the first & last day of the month, it will be delivered around the 20th of the following month. For example, if an order is placed on August 10, it will arrive at the school office around September 20. To avoid shipping charges, choose the "Pick Up My Order" option and your order will be delivered to the school and we will send the item(s) home with your oldest student.

Polos -

<u>New!</u> White short sleeved polos will be available with the "St. Patrick Catholic School" embroidered logo through Sportsprint.

NOTE: Plain white polos will also be acceptable for uniform.

<u>New!</u> <u>Green short-sleeved polos</u> will be available with the "St. Patrick Catholic School" embroidered logo through Sportsprint.

NOTE: Polos with the embroidered cross will still be acceptable for the 21-22 school year. Green short-sleeved polos <u>must be purchased through Sportsprint</u>. No other green colored polos will be acceptable.

We are excited to be offering two types of polos for the fall! There is a racermesh, which is similar to a dri-fit and a 50/50 blend, which is cotton & polyester.

Quarter Zip Pullover -

New! We are offering two types of pullovers, both of which will have the "St. Patrick Catholic School" embroidered logo.

The Augusta Sportswear – similar to a dri-fit – comes in the green and gray. The Cadet Collar – cotton/polyester blend – comes in navy and gray.

NOTE: Quarter-zip pullovers with the embroidered "St. Patrick School cross" logo will be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.

PE uniform (Grades 6 – 8)

New! The logo for the PE t-shirt has changed. It will have the St. Patrick Catholic School logo (screen printed). Note: The current PE t-shirt will be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.

Shorts – New! PE shorts with the "St. Patrick Catholic School" logo are offered online. Shorts from Creative Stitches will still be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.

Preschool & pre-kindergarten t-shirt -

The t-shirt for students in preschool and pre-kindergarten must be purchased through Sportsprint.

NOTE: The current St. Patrick preschool t-shirt will be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.

Preschool & Pre-kindergarten Bag –

The bag must be purchased through Sportsprint and used for preschool and pre-kindergarten.

Other Uniform information -

<u>Pants & Shorts</u> – Navy blue shorts and pants must follow the uniform guidelines as stated in the handbook.

<u>Crewneck Sweatshirt</u> – The green "St. Patrick" embroidered crewneck sweatshirt has been eliminated; however, will be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.

<u>Long-sleeved polo</u> – We have eliminated the green long-sleeved polo; however, we are hoping the dri-fit style pullover will be a nice replacement. The current green long-sleeved polo will be acceptable for the 21-22 school year.
