SPIRIT DAY DRESS OUT GUIDELINES:

Student attire contributes in large measure to the atmosphere of the school. While dress out days are uniform-free days, the student's attire should always reflect a level of modesty that demonstrates one's commitment to the Catholic values of self-respect and should reflect the dignity of one who is a child of God.

The following are **Spirit Day** guidelines:

- Shirt must be a St. Patrick Spirit Day shirt purchased from Creative Stitches <u>or Sportsprint</u> or a collared uniform shirt
- Pants must be an acceptable out-of-uniform pant—loose fitting only (i.e. jeans, athletic pants or khakis)
- <u>Uniform Shorts or Spirit Shorts purchased from Sportsprint are the ONLY shorts</u> allowed on Spirit Dress Out Days. Grades 6-8 may wear PE shorts on Spirit Days.
- Athletic shoes must be worn that fit snuggly on the feet secured by Velcro or shoelaces.
- Sock of some sort must be worn.

ATTENTION ALL VOLUNTEERS



Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees, and volunteers) in the Archdiocese is required to register in the new Prevent & Protect system. This includes those who have already taken a Protecting God's Children (PGC) Workshop. If you volunteer in any capacity at St. Patrick School, PSR, or St. Patrick Parish, you need to re-register.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.

The deadline to register in the new system is December 31, 2020. Please don't wait! To date, only 243 St. Patrick employees/volunteers have fulfilled all the necessary requirements.

The system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY AT-TENDED-DATE NOT LISTED" and send an email to rebecca@stpatsch org and Rebecca will apply the correct training record to your account.


