Dear St. Patrick School families,

I would like to take a minute of your time to introduce myself to you and explain a few of the changes that you are experiencing during these first weeks of school regarding tuition, aftercare, etc.

My name is Julie Ramacciotti and I am the new business manager for St. Patrick Church & School. I have been working in this capacity for 9 years and have worked at several churches and schools. I am excited to be a part of the team at St. Patrick! My husband and I are members of St. Clare of Assisi Parish and have three grown children (all living on the east coast) and a beautiful "almost" 2-year-old granddaughter, Lucy.

One of the biggest changes you will see concerning tuition is that we will be using FACTS for everyone. Just to put you at ease, there is NO charge for FACTS if you make one payment in full AND the 2% discount still applies. We are currently in the process of adding everyone to FACTS. In addition to invoicing for tuition, we will be using a feature in FACTS called "Incidental Billing" (no additional charge for this). This will allow us to invoice families for morning care, after care, field trips, etc. all through FACTS with no money travelling from parent, to child, to teacher, to school office, to parish office!

You will always be notified several times from FACTS when you have been invoiced for something, the email will tell you what the invoice if for, i.e. "Field Trip", the amount, and when the payment is due. You will receive a second notification from FACTS a few days before the withdrawal. Lots of communication about what is happening. NO MONEY WILL EVER BE WITHDRAWN WITHOUT YOU KNOWING ABOUT IT WELL IN ADVANCE. This information and withdrawal will be completely separate from your tuition withdrawal if you are a family who pays monthly.

The amount of money (cash & checks) that moves through school is astounding! Part of my new position will be to review procedures and policies and provide suggestions/options to staff to eliminate the handling of money. To this extent, the FACTS system provides a great option for collection of money.

I look forward to getting to know the families of St. Patrick School and helping you in any way possible. Thank you in advance for your support of the changes that are occurring. Please feel free to contact me with questions at any time.

With a joyful heart, I ask St. Patrick to bless all of our families, faculty and staff.
