

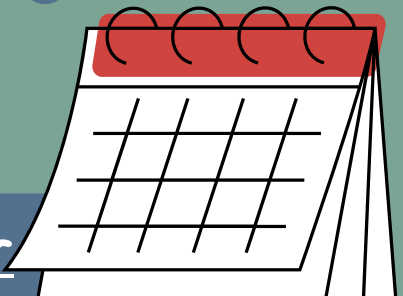

# TRUNK OR TREAT GUIDELINES

## THIS IS A **FAMILY EVENT** FOR ST. PATRICK FAMILIES ONLY

It is a fun, safe event where families decorate their trunks and pass out candy to all the kids.

If you plan to participate with your vehicle at the Trunk or Treat, please read the following:

1. **RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED! Limited spaces available; first reserved, first served!** See #11 below. After registering, you will receive a "permit" to place on your dashboard for entrance into the lot.
2. Trunk or Treat will be **weather permitting**. If cancelled, an email will be sent.
3. This is a **family event**, dropping off your children is NOT an option.
4. **Parking lot opens at 6:30 pm** to allow time to set up your trunks. Pay close attention to the parking lot attendants. They will be directing traffic to ensure all spaces are filled. Please DO NOT skip spaces. If everyone shows up that registered, we will use ALL parking spaces plus some. We will have cars line up similar to school carpool and will park cars similar to church parking.
5. **Open up and decorate your trunk** or the back of your vehicle. There are some great trunk decorating ideas on the Internet. Please refrain from anything overly spooky or gory. Possibilities could include a Halloween theme, sports, comic characters, Biblical, exotic locations, a particular decade- and can be as elaborate or simple as you wish. If lights are needed, please make sure they're battery powered, as electricity will not be available on-site.
6. **Parking lot will close at 7:00.** At that time no one will be allowed into the parking lot to ensure the safety of everyone involved and the children will be allowed to start trick or treating.
7. **The parking lot will reopen at 8:30 when it is safe for cars to begin leaving.** No one will be allowed to leave early! At that time everyone must be in their cars and you will be dismissed in an orderly fashion similar to school carpool.
8. Approximately **200 children** are participating, so remember to bring lots of candy to pass out. Don't forget your trick or treat bags!
9. For **candy**, please only bring store-bought, individually-wrapped treats. Small trinkets are also acceptable.
10. Everyone helping at Trunk or Treat is encouraged to **wear a family-friendly costume**.
11. **RSVP online at [bit.ly/39libKL](http://bit.ly/39libKL) by Tues, October 17.** Pizza requests are also on the online form.
12. **Marco's Pizza orders and money** are due NO LATER than **Friday, October 13.** Return your payment for pizza in an envelope marked with your name and \$13 for each pizza to the school or parish office.
13. We are looking for **10 volunteers** to help. You may sign up online at [bit.ly/3ArDBBT](http://bit.ly/3ArDBBT).
14. **Have fun and BE SAFE!** Bring some lawn chairs to sit in and hand out candy to the kids! Compliment costumes! Meet a family! Have a great time!

We will provide a container for any left-over candy if you want to have it donated to a local charity.
