

- 6) **The First Miracle at Cana.** Christ performs his first miracle by changing water into wine at the wedding at Cana. This is prophetic sign of the institution of the Eucharist and a sign of the festive aspect of the Eucharist. The wheel light shows a chalice – where wine itself is changed into His Body and Blood.



- 7) **(Under the Balcony).** The two lights show Christ with the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The wheel light which is visible only in the balcony shows Christ as the Agnus Dei (The Lamb of God) who was given in sacrifice. The Lamb is shown with the flag of victory. (Apocalypse, 17:1-4)



- 8) **(Under the Balcony).** The two lights show the Sorrowful Christ and The Mother of Sorrows. The wheel light shows the bishop's mitre and the keys by which the sins of men and women are loosed.

9) **Christ Blessing the Children** (Matthew 19:13-15). The wheel light has the inscription “JESUS.”



10) The Baptism of Christ in the River Jordan. Christ is baptized by John the Baptist in the River Jordan. A Dove appears over Christ, and a Voice of the Father says that “You are My Son in Whom I am well pleased.” (Luke 3:22). The wheel light shows a lyre, an ancient Christian symbol. St. Clement of Alexandria said that the lyre was an acceptable symbol for Christians to exhibit. The lyre is also a symbol of praise to the Lord, echoing David in the Old Testament.
