



PRIVACY CHANGE EMAIL

On Monday, Jan. 24th, you should receive two emails. The first email will alert you to a change in privacy settings. We will update your privacy settings to make your address and email visible in the parish directory, and to ensure that only parish office staff can see your personal information. Since many families now only have cell phone numbers, we have opted not to automatically include phone numbers in the directory. If you feel comfortable, we hope you will change your privacy settings to allow your home and/or cell phone number to be seen by anyone in the parish, but that is a personal decision. If you need help changing your privacy settings, we have a howto guide on the homepage of the parish website, or you can call the parish office and we can make the change for you.

REALM EMAIL INVITATION

The second email you will receive on Monday, Jan. 24th, is an invitation to join Realm. The link in the invitation will allow you to create your account. Once you have set up your account, you can login to Realm online through your computer, or you can download the *Realm Connect – For Our Church* app in the Apple App Store (for iPhones) or the Google Play Store (for Androids). See the parish website for a how -to guide on setting up your account, or call the parish office, if you need assistance.

UPDATED EMAIL ADDRESSES


If you do not receive the emails we send on Jan. 24th, it likely means we do not have a working email address for you. Call the parish office, or email Lindsey Ziliak with your name and current email address, and we will send you the Realm invitation right away. If you do not have an email address and

would like to use the features of Realm, we encourage you to set an email address up. Once you do create an email address, contact the parish office or email Lindsey with the new information, and we will send you the Realm invite.

REALM HELP SESSIONS JAN 29TH & 30TH

During the coming week, we encourage you to set up your account and explore some of the Realm features. If you have trouble with any aspects of Realm, we will have volunteers with Realm experience available after all Masses on Jan. 29th and 30th. Several volunteers will be set up in the church lobby with a computer to assist parishioners. More volunteers, and computers, will be available in the cafeteria. Parishioners will have the opportunity to take photos for their profiles. We also will provide cookies after the Saturday Mass, and donuts and coffee following the Sunday Masses.

We invite you to join us to learn more about Realm, while celebrating the rollout of this tool that we believe will help us grow closer as a parish as we minister together on our journey of faith.

DIOCESAN COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

According to the Diocese of Evansville COVID-19 protocols, parishes in counties that are classified red by the Indiana State Department of Health must require masks at all parish non-liturgical events.

Anytime Vanderburgh County is red, this requirement applies to Resurrection. A non-liturgical event is any event/gathering/meeting in parish facilities.

This does not apply to Masses, baptisms, weddings, or funerals, which are considered liturgical events. Masks continue to be strongly recommended for liturgical events.
