Volunteer Job Descriptions

All adults involved in our program must complete a criminal background check and attend a "Virtus—Protecting God's Children Seminar."

All volunteers have certain expectations

Participation at weekly Mass.

Arrive 10 minutes prior to session time.

Consistent and reliable attendance at your session.

Some Additional Catechist/Aid Expectations

Advanced preparation of lesson plan. (catechists only)

Available to substitute in the event of a catechist absence (aids only).

Attendance at catechist meetings and in-services.

An accumulation of 6 or more hours of training while working toward diocesan certification.

Some Additional Babysitter Expectations

Assist preschoolers with all their needs.

Good communication with parents of children.

Some Additional Monitor Expectations

Monitor children at curb and with doors.

Monitor children in hallways and bathrooms.

Assist catechist with a variety of tasks.

Stay until last child is picked up.

Sacrament Teams Expectations

Two teams, one for 2nd grade and one for Confirmation. There is a total of 5-6 events per team as well as 1-2 preparation meetings.

Provide set up and take down at all sacramental events.

Provide hospitality when needed.
