- **THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD** This Sunday marks the beginning of Ordinary Time for this new liturgical year, and we celebrate God's revealing Himself to us in the manifestation of Himself as three divine persons of the Holy Trinity - all present at Christ's Baptism in the river Jordan. The voice of the Father speaks. The God-man, Jesus Christ the Son is present to us in holy flesh and blood. The Holy Spirit descends and thus, the Holy Sacrament of Baptism is established by the full presence of the Holy Trinity. - **OKC MARCH FOR LIFE JAN 22nd!** Our annual state march will begin with a kick-off rally at the Oklahoma State Capitol Building (South Plaza). The Diocese of Tulsa is chartering buses to travel from Tulsa to OKC (Covid-19 precautions in place so seating is limited). Bus tickets are \$15.00 and registration for tickets & event permission forms for adults will close January 15. The flow of events this year is as follows:
 - **9:30 am – Pre-March Rally:** Live music, food trucks in front of the Capitol, Pro-life organizations will have their booths set up in the plaza for viewing
 - **10:30 am – Speakers**
 - **11:00 am – March Begins:** Starting at the Capitol and ending about two miles away at the Midtown Triangle near St. Anthony's Hospital
