SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON EVENTS ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI PARISH FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM

MASKS

Attendees must wear face masks while in the building. This excludes the following: anyone under the age of 2, anyone with trouble breathing, anyone incapacitated or unable to remove the mask without assistance.

SYMPTOMS

Attendees with the following symptoms of COVID-19 should not enter the church building:

- Fever (feeling feverish, or a documented temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher).
- Respiratory symptoms such as runny nose, nasal congestion, sore throat, cough, or shortness of breath (other than seasonal allergy symptoms).
- Whole body symptoms such as muscle aches, chills, and severe fatigue.
- Gastrointestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
- Changes in your sense of taste or smell.

RISK FACTORS

Attendees with the following risk factors for COVID-19 should not enter the church building:

- Close contact with someone who is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days. (Note: Healthcare workers caring for COVID-19 patients while wearing appropriate personal protective equipment are not considered to be exposed.)
- Travel in the past 14 days outside of New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut, or Rhode Island for non-essential purposes.

If anyone has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days (from the test date or from the date symptoms first appeared), then they should not enter the church.
