HEART OF A SHEPHERD – As a reminder, this special Diocesan initiative seeks to raise funds to renovate, repair, and refurbish the Seminary Facilities; help support the newly ordained in offering some financial relief following ordination; and provide proper care of our priests who have dedicated their lives to shepherding our faith.
