DON'T FORGET – copies of the weekly bulletin, the Take 5's for the current week, and Fr Mike's previous homily are available in the Parish Office during office hours Mon-Fri 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS AS WE RETURN TO MASS:

- (1) Social distancing is to be observed.
- (2) Sanitize hands before entering the Church building.
- (3) Masks are required*. **IF POSSIBLE, THIS APPLIES ALSO TO CHILDREN OVER 2 YEARS OF AGE.*
- (4) Observe "one-way" aisles for movement into Church, during Mass, and exiting Church.
- (5) Observe designated pews for seating and social distancing while in the pews, as well as coming forward/and returning after/for Communion.
- (6) Observe Restroom protocols.
- (7) Doors to the Church will be open ½ hour before each Mass and locked once Mass begins.
- (8) Doors will be locked* once Mass has ended and all have exited the Church building (to allow time for sanitization.) **Monday-Thursday, doors will be locked at 10:00 AM.*
- (9) The Church will not be open on Fridays.
- (10) Sanitize hands after leaving the Church.
