**Her yes set in motion the ultimate redemption of humanity and confirmed her as the first among all Disciples of your Son.**

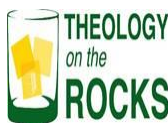
**As she stood by your Son's Cross, she showed herself to be the mother of all who would believe in Him, and the mother of your Church.**
