OFFICE CLOSED Memorial Day, Monday, May 25.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE CHANGES IN MASS TIMES IN THE UPPER LEFT COLUMN. Daily Mass will be Monday – Thursday at 8:30 am; there is no Mass on Friday; Saturday Mass is 5:00 pm; and Sunday Masses will be at 8:30 am and 11:00 am. Weekdays the church will close shortly after Mass is completed, sanitizing will take place, and the church will remain closed after sanitizing, until the next Mass. The 1st Mass on Sundays will begin ½ hour earlier (at 8:30 am) in order to leave time for sanitizing before the 11:00 Mass begins. Again the church will then remain closed until the next Mass.



Because we are not fully back to celebrating all things Liturgical in the church building at this time, we have also added a letter code next to the time of each Mass/Service in parenthesis to let you know the place in which that service will be held. **The Key is as follows: C – Church; PC – Parish Center; PL – Parking Lot.** Example: Monday, May 25th, Daily Mass will begin at 8:30 am in the Church. Please note that all services held in the Parish Center will be celebrated privately at this time and live-streamed, but you may tune in to the parish facebook page, uploaded to Vimeo, or YouTube.

Also, please note we are not ready to resume Saturday morning Confessions at this time. Stay tuned . . .

ASCENSION OF THE LORD

IMPORTANT CHURCH/MASS INFORMATION:

- (1) Social distancing is to be observed.
- (2) Hands are to be sanitized before entering the Church building.
- (3) Masks are required*. **IF POSSIBLE, THIS APPLIES ALSO TO CHILDREN OVER 2 YEARS OF AGE.*
- (4) Observe "one-way" aisles for movement into Church, during Mass, and exiting Church.
- (5) Observe designated pews for seating and social distancing while in the pews, as well as coming forward/and returning after/for Communion.
- (6) Observe Restroom protocols.
- (7) Doors to the Church will be open ½ hour before each Mass and locked once Mass begins.
- (8) Doors will be locked* once Mass has ended and all have exited the Church building (to allow time for sanitization.) **Monday-Thursday, doors will be locked at 10:00 AM.*
- (9) The Church will not be open on Fridays.
- (10) Hands should be sanitized after leaving the Church.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES UPDATE - Because of you, thousands of people across our diocese have found help and hope. Requests for assistance have increased drastically since the pandemic began. Hot meal programs that transitioned to a takeout model saw an increase of up to 50%. St. Augustine Hunger Center is delivering more than 500 meals per day to those in need, pre-packaged pantry distribution has increased up to 3x more than before the pandemic began, and the St. Elizabeth Center shelter is practicing social distancing by moving all clients to motels. **As of April 30th, Our Lady of Victory, has reached 89% of our goal!** Thank you!
