A Note from Father Mike

A good number of our parishioners use Faith Direct as a means of making regular donations for the support of the parish. Faith Direct is one method of "electronic giving", meaning that their donations are made online over the internet. This method of donating is becoming much more common—and popular—as the traditional methods of donating cash or writing checks can be a bit more involved. "E-giving" means that folks use their credit cards or direct transfers from their bank accounts. While it seems like it might be riskier, it's a more secure way of giving, with many protections, firewalls, and cybersecurity elements in place. Of course, we appreciate the donations and support of our parishioners, in whatever way they choose to give!

I am writing about this now to get more information out regarding a big change at Faith Direct. In truth, the biggest "Faith Direct" is becoming change is in the name! "ParishSoft Giving." These had been two distinct companies, and some months ago, they merged, taking on the new name. (I think the idea was a "take-off" on "Microsoft", although I would have stuck with Faith Direct for a name!) Parishioners who have used Faith Direct in the past and signed up for Payment Email Reminders initially, should have already been informed of this change, or soon will be. The changes are relatively small. There will be a few more options for donors in regard to timing, but most folks won't even notice the change. We have been told that this change is not in any way a sign of instability in the company. In fact, ParishSoft will be a stronger and more secure company. If you have any questions about this change, please contact me at the Parish Office, or contact ParishSoft directly!

Again, my thanks for your continued support of our parish! It is the responsibility of each one of us to support the ministry of the Church. Without that support, we would not be able to carry on the mission of the Church or of our parish. Thank you very much!
