YEAR-END CONTRIBUTIONS

COLLECTION BOXES - All donations received in the collection boxes through Sunday evening Mass, Dec 31 will go toward your 2023 Contributions. Donations received in the collection box beginning Monday, Jan 1, 2024, must go toward your 2024 Contributions no matter the date on the check, per the Internal Revenue Service.

MAILED-IN CONTRIBUTIONS - If the **postmark** on the outside of the envelope is dated for 2023, it will be recorded as a 2023 contribution. If the **postmark** is dated for 2024, it will be recorded as a 2024 contribution; again, no matter the date on the check. **The date of the postmark** is the **most important**, not the date on the check, again, per the IRS.

FOR FAITH DIRECT USERS, they will be accepting one-time Checking/Savings account gifts and live one-time credit card gifts until *midnight on December 31* if you'd like to do an end-of-year contribution.


