REFLECTIONS FROM GREG WASINSKI: YOU ARE WORTHY - I grew up in the first part of my "Catholic" life without realizing What/Who was



present before me every Mass in the Eucharist. Now, I'm inviting you into a new level of relationship with Christ through Holy Communion. Leading up to my Parish Mission for Our Lady of Victory March 17-19, I'll be sharing a few simple thoughts to begin guiding you on some of the points I will touch upon, as they relate to reviving our soul through the Eucharist.

We start with two aspects of our Catholic life that help form the foundation to feel the presence of Christ in the Eucharist: Desire and Worthiness. Jesus always accepts us despite our brokenness or lack of understanding of what is hidden from our human senses in Holy Communion. We are worthy because of His mercy. He craves a relationship with us and is always looking for us to accept His unconditional love. We show Him our love in return by how much we desire to receive Him.

Reflection Question:

What do you want from Jesus in this Sacrament? Is there anything holding vou back?
