ALEX KRUKEMEYER TO BE INSTITUTED INTO THE MINISTRY OF ACOLYTE . . . On Friday, February 9th , our seminarian, Alex Krukemeyer, will be instituted by Bishop Malesic into the Ministry of Acolyte, the first of two ministries received prior to ordination to the diaconate and priesthood. In the Catholic Church, a person is instituted an Acolyte to assist the priest in the celebration of the Eucharist, especially setting up the altar and distributing Holy Communion. However, they may also distribute Holy Communion to the sick, and expose the Blessed Sacrament for Eucharistic Adoration, when a priest or deacon is unavailable. The *institution* of an individual into this Ministry has its origins in what was once known as "Minor Orders" in the Church, and as such, is reserved only for those individuals in formation for priesthood. While local parishes also have these Ministries (Acolyte/Server and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, of which both female and males can exercise when called upon) at the Parish level, these individuals are commissioned and not instituted. Alex has prepared for this ministry so that, as the prayer over the candidates states, "Make your life worthy of your service at the table of the Lord and of His Church." While no one can make their life worthy on their effort alone, everything is possible through receptivity and openness to God's grace and mercy. Please continue to pray for Alex's openness as he receives this important ministry and continues his journey of formation and discernment to priesthood in the Diocese of Cleveland.




