A Note from Father Mike

Most folks are aware that we are blessed to have two young men from our parish who are enrolled in the process of formation for the Diocese of Cleveland. Krukemeyer is currently in his third year at Saint Mary During this year of preparation, the Seminary. seminarians are assigned to a particular parish to learn and experience more about the real "day-to-day" life and ministry of a parish priest. Alex will be living and working at Saint Bernard/Saint Mary Parish in downtown Akron. Vince Labosky has just completed his first full year of formation, which is called a "propaedeutic" year. That unusual name for the first year of formation simply refers to an intense time of spiritual formation and invites the seminarians to engage in a variety of experiences that contribute to their overall personal formation. During the past year, Vince and the other seminarians in his group traveled to various sites around the area and the wider country, gaining a wealth of experience on a very basic level. The propaedeutic year may have been highlighted by a trip to Spain, where the seminarians traveled a good portion of the "Camino de Santiago." The Camino is a series of pilgrimages that lead to Galicia, a city in northern Spain where, tradition holds, the remains of the apostle are buried in the cathedral church. Back in the Middle Ages, pilgrims would sometimes travel the Camino "walking" on their knees as penance for their sins. (Not sure if Vince did that or not!)

In any case, Alex is already living at Saint Bernard, learning about daily life in a parish, and Vince is at home preparing to restart classes in the fall. In the meantime, we keep both young men in our prayers!


