A Note from Father Mike

In the Gospel for this weekend, we hear one of the versions of the "Lord's Prayer", this one from the Gospel of Luke. The version that appears in the Gospel of Matthew is the one that we know well and may have memorized, and the prayer has (probably) become part of our daily prayer. Of course, *Matthew's version is also the one that we pray at Mass. Why* are there two "versions" of the prayer? When the authors of the Gospels wrote their works, they were basing them on what is called "the oral tradition," which basically means that since no one was writing down what Jesus said or did at the time, the stories about his teaching were retold in community settings. Only many years later were the stories written down. When the authors did write, they tried to emphasize certain aspects of the teaching of Jesus. One of the aspects that Luke's Gospel focuses on is God's personal care for each person, and how every disciple is called into a relationship with Jesus. So, his "retelling" of how Jesus taught his disciples to pray is in the context of a larger theme of the need to be persistent in prayer and to trust in God's love for each one of us. Jesus was teaching his disciples (and us) not what to pray but how to pray: with an attitude of faith and trust in God's love!

Two recent events demonstrate well the new partnership between Saint Matthew and Our Lady of Victory parishes. The recent "Christmas in July" sale at OLV was an excellent way to support both parishes: the Ladies' Guild at OLV, which sponsored the event, and the fall "Happy Holly-Days" Bazaar at Saint Matthew, a pre-Christmas event that everyone looks forward to. As we move forward, we look forward to many other opportunities to "partner" in faith formation, prayer, service, and community events. While the partnering of our parishes came about because of "the curse" of a shortage of priests, the Lord will help us work together to turn it into a blessing!


