A Note from Father Mike

Back in 2008, Saint Matthew Parish was looking for a Director of Music Ministry to lead our choirs and develop a broad ministry of liturgical music. The long-time music director had retired and his successor, while quite successful, had married and moved out of town. I had already worked a bit with Bridget Jankowski, who had served as a substitute musician several times when the regular director was away. Reluctant at first because of her work as a piano instructor, Bridget eventually agreed to take the position at Saint Matthew. For many years, then, Bridget grew and developed the music ministry at Saint Matthew, including an adult choir, a children's choir, a funeral choir, a bell choir, and a host of instrumentalist and musicians of all kinds. By next week, she will be in Morocco, learning a new language and culture, and doing whatever it is that the Peace Corps does. Bridget has only been at Our Lady of Victory for a few months, but she will surely be missed. This weekend we send Bridget off with our prayers and our blessings. May the Lord bless and protect her in this new chapter of her life! Thank you, Bridget!
