**Volunteer to Sew a Surgical Mask for Summa Health and Show Support for our Healthcare Professionals at the Hospitals**

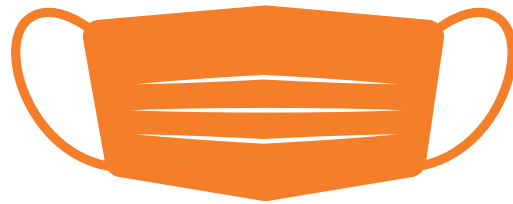
