Irish Oatmeal Bread



6 cups flour sifted
2 ½ cups rolled oats
3 tbsp. baking powder
2 tbsp. salt
2 eggs
½ cup honey
3 cups milk
2 tbsp. butter

Preheat the oven to 350° F. Grease well a loaf pan and set aside.


In a large bowl mix flour, oats, baking powder and salt.

In a medium bowl using a rotary beater, beat egg with honey and milk to mix well.


Pour egg mixture into oats mixture, stirring with a wooden spoon just until dry ingredients are moistened. Mixture will not be smooth.

Spread batter in pan. Bake 1 hour 15 min. or until crusty and tester inserted in the center comes out clean.


Turn loaf out of pan on a wire rack. While still warm, brush with melted butter.
