

Confirmation 2020 – Regulations updated on August 7, 2020

Date:

Next Friday, August 14, 2020 during 5:30 pm Mass at All Saints Church with Archbishop Rozanski.

In emergency cases due to Covid-19 new state restrictions:

If you traveled recently to those states that are on the High-risk list. Archbishop gave permission to Fr. Piotr to Confirm those students on Sunday, August 16, 2020.

That also applies to those who are having major concerns of being in the Church with large number of people due to some medical condition. **Please let Father Piotr know no later than Sunday,**

August 9 if you are choosing that option.

However, we highly recommend to be confirm by Bishop

Candidates:

- Please arrived no later than: 5:00 pm at the Parish Hall or Outside of the Rectory (Weather permitted)
- Be sure that you know where your pew is located in the Church
- After a meeting with Bishop, you will go back to your pew or designated jobs
- Remember to wear Confirmation Name Tag
- Receiving of the Sacrament in following order: side pews, center aisle - starting from the back of the Church
- REMIND YOUR SPONOR what should do during Sacrament takes place
- PLEASE FOLLOW Guidance of the ushers
- Communion: Side pews - staying in the pews and Priests will go to you
- Center Aisle: pew by pew - allowed by ushers
- Pictures at the end of Mass - social distance, all are ask to remind in their pews until they are approach by usher or Father for their term. Immediately after picture was taken you will be asked to leave the Church and DO NOT gather outside. We need to be sure that everyone is feeling saved during whole ceremony and after as well. This is not Walmart :)

All: Due to Covid-19 restrictions and social distance:

- Ceremony closed to public. Only immediate Family Members.
- All will have their temperature checked at their arrival by ushers
- **Please be patience during the ceremony.**
- Masks are required for all in attendance
- **When receiving sacrament:** Each confirmandi will be ask to wipe forehead with a sanitizer wipe -- provided by ushers
- Each Candidate will have 1 pew designate for family - Due to social distance and 40% of capacity of the Church. No more than 8 people per student
- Parish will provide a photographer who will take a group picture and picture of each person receiving the sacrament and Picture at the end of the Ceremony.
- Confirmation Mass will be recorded by Stanley Ciukaj from Ware TV and showed on Chanel 15 on Sunday, August 16 at 9:30am. You are welcome to contact Mr. Ciukaj if you would like a copy of that Mass. This is a gesture from our parishes for those who will be unable to attend the Ceremony due to all restrictions.
