Your book has two silk ribbons! We recommend placing the first ribbon to mark the beginning of mass found in the front of your book, and the second to mark the reading of the day. Here's how you find your daily reading:

- 1 In the back of your new personal missal, you will find an index of dates for the upcoming liturgical years through 2032.
- 2 You may use this index to identify on what page the readings begin for the upcoming Sunday
- 3 Once you have oriented yourself to the current Sunday in your missal, simply move through the book normally, as each Sunday follows sequentially. Since Easter is different each year, you may need to skip to a different part of the book when the liturgical seasons change. You can refer to the Calendar of Readings to find where these breaks occur.
- 4 Your missal starts in Year A, which corresponds to years 2020, 2023, 2026, 2029, and 2032.
