- Be on time for all scheduled departures and chaperone check in points

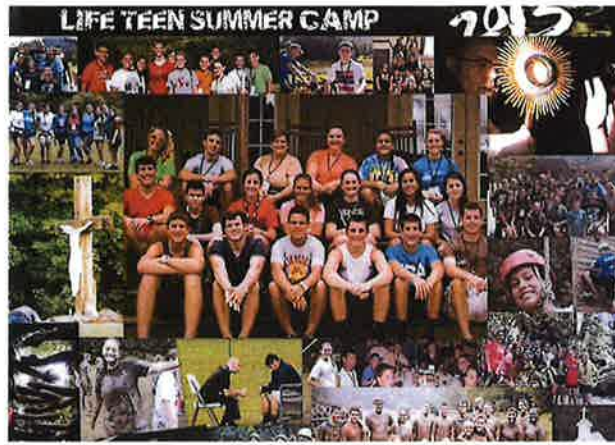
