

Registration Information

Who: All 9th through 12th grade students from the six counties of the Archdiocese of Detroit who wish to come together on an Archdiocesan level to learn more about themselves and their faith. This is an exciting two-day experience of prayer, community and enablement.

How: Registration is accomplished through a designated adult at the parish, high school, or community level. The designated adult should compile all registration forms and submit them via mail in with the completed packet including your parish credit/debit card or parish check for full payment made out to CYO.

For accounting purposes a separate check for youth participation fee is still acceptable—please just memo as such.

Attendance

There is an expected attendance of 1600 youth and adults for the weekend, **for security purposes all youth will stay for the entire weekend at the hotel. No in and out, arriving without group or leaving early without group.**

Accommodations


Things to Remember
