Matthew 5	Isaiah 61
<sup>3</sup> “Blessed <i>are</i> the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.	<sup>1</sup> “The Spirit of the Lord God <i>is</i> upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives,
<sup>4</sup> Blessed <i>are</i> those who mourn, For they shall be comforted	<sup>2</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn,
<sup>5</sup> Blessed <i>are</i> the meek, For they shall inherit the earth.	<sup>7</sup> Instead of your shame <i>you shall have</i> double <i>honor</i> , and <i>instead of</i> confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs.
<sup>6</sup> Blessed <i>are</i> those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.	<sup>6</sup> But you shall be named the priests of the Lord, They shall call you the servants of our God. You shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, And in their glory you shall boast.
<sup>10</sup> Blessed <i>are</i> those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.	<sup>3</sup> To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.”
<sup>11</sup> Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great <i>is</i> your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.	<sup>10</sup> I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness... So the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.
