Traditionally, Thanksgiving is a time of parish sharing with those in our community who are less fortunate than ourselves. This year will be no exception as we have been asked to assist 150 families in the City of Warwick.

As we do each year, we are asking parishioners to bring in canned goods to the Church. From now until Sunday November 19th, please bring in food items to the church during the week or at the weekend Masses and leave in the baskets at the entry doors of the church. In order to have consistent items in each basket, please bring in the following items:

- Canned vegetables, such as peas, corn, green beans
- Stuffing mix
- Cranberry sauce
- Turkey gravy
- Dessert mixes, such as cakes, muffins or puddings

Also, there are sign-up sheets at the church entrances to sign up to donate a turkey, or sort, pack and distribute the food.

If you wish to make a monetary donation to help to pay for the fresh produce that we buy to go into each basket (bread, onions, carrots, potatoes and apples), please put it in an envelope marked "Thanksgiving Food Drive" and put it in the collection basket at Mass or hand it in at the Church office.

Your contributions will be greatly appreciated by those needy families of our City and we thank you for your continued support each year.
